Known for their tight vocal harmonies, varied instrumentation and repertoire, CityFolk's repertoire encompasses a broad variety of musical styles that includes such artists as Simon and Garfunkel, Peter, Paul and Mary, Jim Croce, Norah Jones, Van Morrison, Brandi Carlile, Joni Mitchell, Judy Collins, Kathy Mattea, Mary Chapin Carpenter, Dan Fogelberg, and Crosby, Stills, and Nash. CityFolk has released their debut CD, *The Music Always Wins* that contains a collection of their compositions as well as arrangements of some of their favorite music that spans from folk to jazz.

We have performed at numerous restaurants, festivals, concerts, clubs, and coffee houses throughout the Triangle area for over 15 years including ongoing engagements at the Irregardless Café in Raleigh and the Pittsboro Roadhouse. In addition, we have opened for nationally known folk artists Kate Campbell and Carrie Newcomer.
